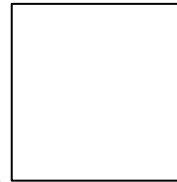

Enclosed is the schedule for the remainder of the year as well as picture & show information.

Monday skaters, your last regular scheduled class is Monday, January 26th and Saturday skaters your last regular class is Saturday, January 31st.

At the beginning of February your child's group will skate ONLY on the specific dates and times listed below. Groups are assigned to the day and coach you skate with.

If you are unsure what group or who your child's coach is, then please reach out.

Students that are not participating in the show may come and skate during their group's scheduled time, however, there will be no lesson, and no direct supervision. There will be a small area where they can do free skating.

Our Show theme is "Road Trip"

It is important that you make every effort to attend these practices and arrive **at least 15 minutes** prior to your scheduled time. This is the on-ice time, not arrival time. Please understand that two or more missed practices may compromise your child's participation in the show as absences make it difficult to choreograph and teach the routine to others who are present. unforeseen circumstances are understood. If groups require additional practices, and ice time becomes available, this might result in you being given short notice of 24-48 hours.

Waivers will need to be signed by all participants who are nonmembers, and you are then committing to attending the scheduled practice times. At no time other than dress rehearsal or show night are costumes to be worn. If pieces are lost, they cannot be replaced.

Dress Rehearsal is Saturday, February 21nd at 1:00PM. All Skaters must report to locker rooms 6 & 7 by 12:30PM and check the sheet listed outside for your groups room assignment. Costumes are to be worn. The finale number will be practiced first and then we'll run through the rest of the entire program. Bring a snack and maybe a blanket so your child will be warm while watching the dress rehearsal. Dress rehearsal should last approximately 2.5 to 3 hours.

The show date is Sunday, February 22nd at 2:00PM. All skaters must arrive by 1:00PM and report to their assigned locker rooms. Parents will then exit the rink and return to the lobby and wait for the doors to open. The rink will be closed off to **everyone** other than those individuals helping with set up. If you are not signed up to help with setting up, you will be asked to exit. **NO RESERVING OF SEATS except the volunteers assisting with the set-up. SET UP VOLUNTEERS ARE PERMITTED 4 seats only.** Set up time is **12:00PM on Sunday Feb. 22nd.** Anyone volunteering must also remain after the show to assist with tearing down. A link to sign up to volunteer will be forthcoming. We thank you in advance for your co-operation.

Tickets are \$10.00 each, children 3 and under are free. Tickets are available online.
